On behalf of Dashmesh Culture Center and Khalsa School Calgary we would like to put forward a request to present the Khalsa School Calgary Expansion Plans in Conrich.

Following Is a brief summary of our organizations:

The Dashmesh Culture Centre was built in 1987 with the help of community members, the City of Calgary, and the Alberta government at the time. Since then, we have been guided by the vision from the Sikh community in the early 80's to provide a cultural center for the community to gather and build a better future for new generations.

Through the years, the DCC has grown to a membership of 15,000 plus, serving a community of 100,000 strong. From the vision of the community in the early 80's to current times, we have flourished and provided a beautiful centre for the Sikh community to gather and celebrate all of our religious events.

Khalsa School Calgary was founded in 2007 by the Dashmesh Culture Centre to provide excellence in education while providing an environment rich in Sikh culture, values, beliefs, traditions and principles. The school opened on September 4, 2007 with fifty-seven students in grades K-4, five certified teachers and three support staff.

Currently, the school has over 600 hundred students in grades K -9, thirty-three certified teachers, and nineteen support staff members. Since the school's founding, the original building has undergone numerous improvements. Fourteen additional classrooms were added in September 2012 to support the school growth, a new gymnasium was built with

community support in May 2014, and a new Learning Commons was introduced in May 2019. Most recently a new wing with eight new classrooms and state of the art turf field was built in 2023 with fundraising of approx. \$1.5M dollars.

It is important to note that the new turf field and gymnasium are public facilities for the residents of Rocky View County outside of the regular school hours.

School is constantly undergoing renovations and upgrades as the strength of students is increasing. With recent ranking of 15th out of 848 schools in Alberta our wait lists are growing rapidly. Original building of the school is outdated and almost at end of life. Dasmesh Culture Center and Khalsa School Board is looking to build a new school facility along with track and field grounds for the students and residents of Rocky View County.

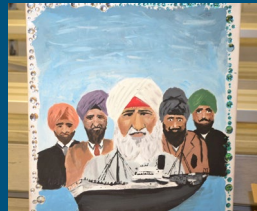
The school opened on September 4, 2007 with fifty-six (56) students in grades K-4, six certificated teachers and three other staff. Since its humble beginning the school has thrived and grown.

Today the school boasts a student population of **600+ students** in grades K-9, **33 certificated teachers** and **17 support staff** members.

The original facility has undergone many upgrades since the school's inception with the most recent being the addition of 8 classrooms for Junior High.

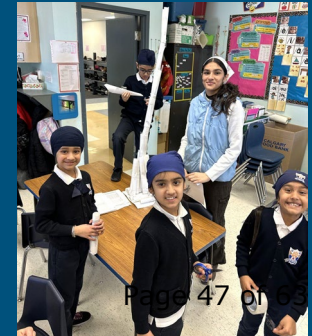

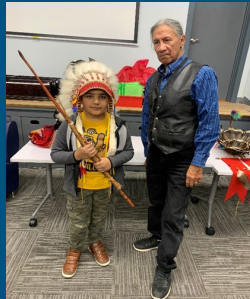

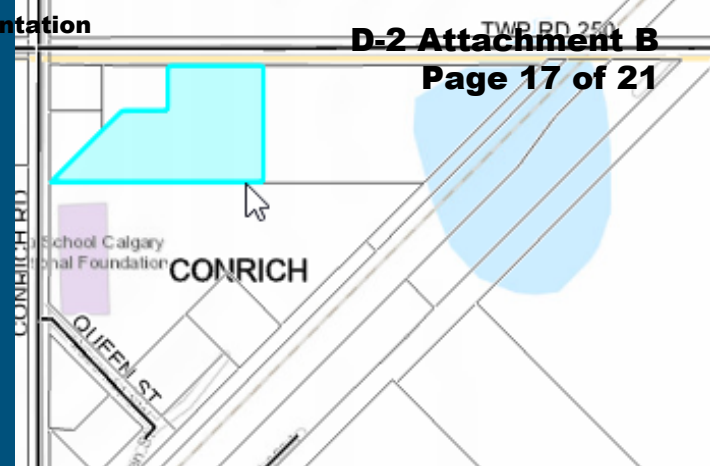

Areal View of the School



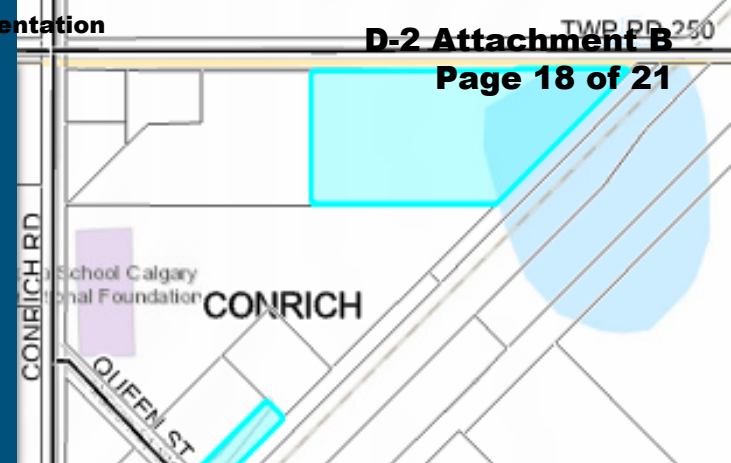
Adjacent Land Parcel 1

- Roll 04333040 – Zoned S-Pub – 3.88 Acres - It's a zoning designation that allows for a variety of public service uses, such as schools, utilities, and other similar facilities
- Dashmesh Culture Center (DCC) along with Rocky view County and Board of Trustees of Rocky view School district entered a lease for 10 years which is set to expire in Oct 2028
- Lease to auto renew for term for 10 years if there is no written notice from either party and can be terminated without cause by either party with 30 days notice
- Leased land can only be used for the following:
 - Public Park
 - Public Recreational Facility
 - Any other Recreational Activities approved by the owners



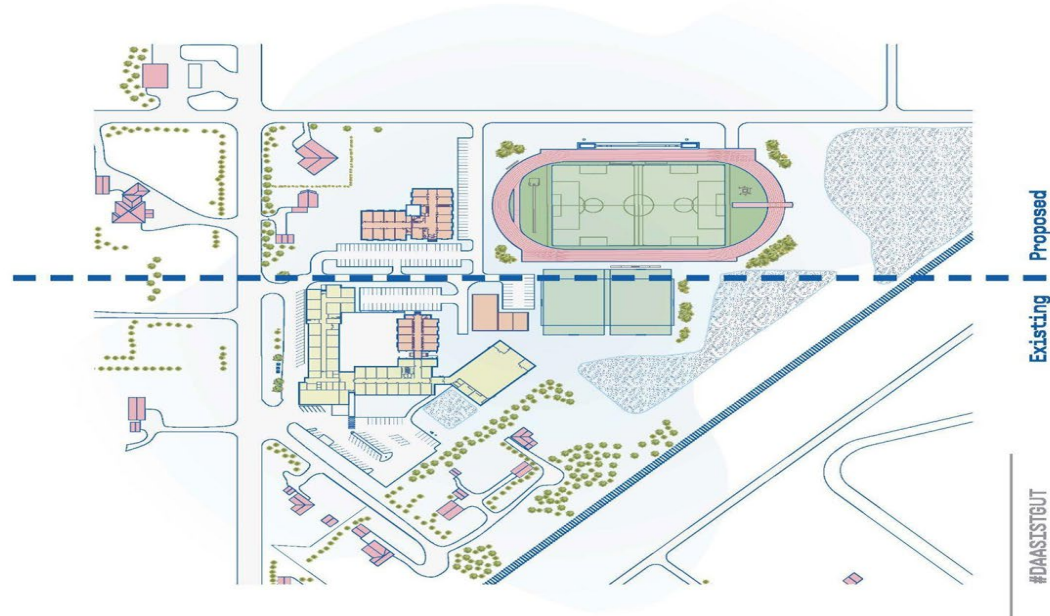

- Expanding Khalsa School would make the area more appealing to families who prefer living near educational facilities—likely spurring residential growth in Conrich.
- Expansion will encourage developers to develop lands in and around the school thereby increasing the economic activity.
- Adding a Track & Field recreational facility alongside an expanded school would serve both students and the wider community, offering a long-term public asset
- The lease that Dashmesh Culture Center (DCC) has in place does not allow for building new structures. DCC would like to request Rockyview County and Rocky view School District to consider purchasing the two land parcels for Khalsa School Expansion
