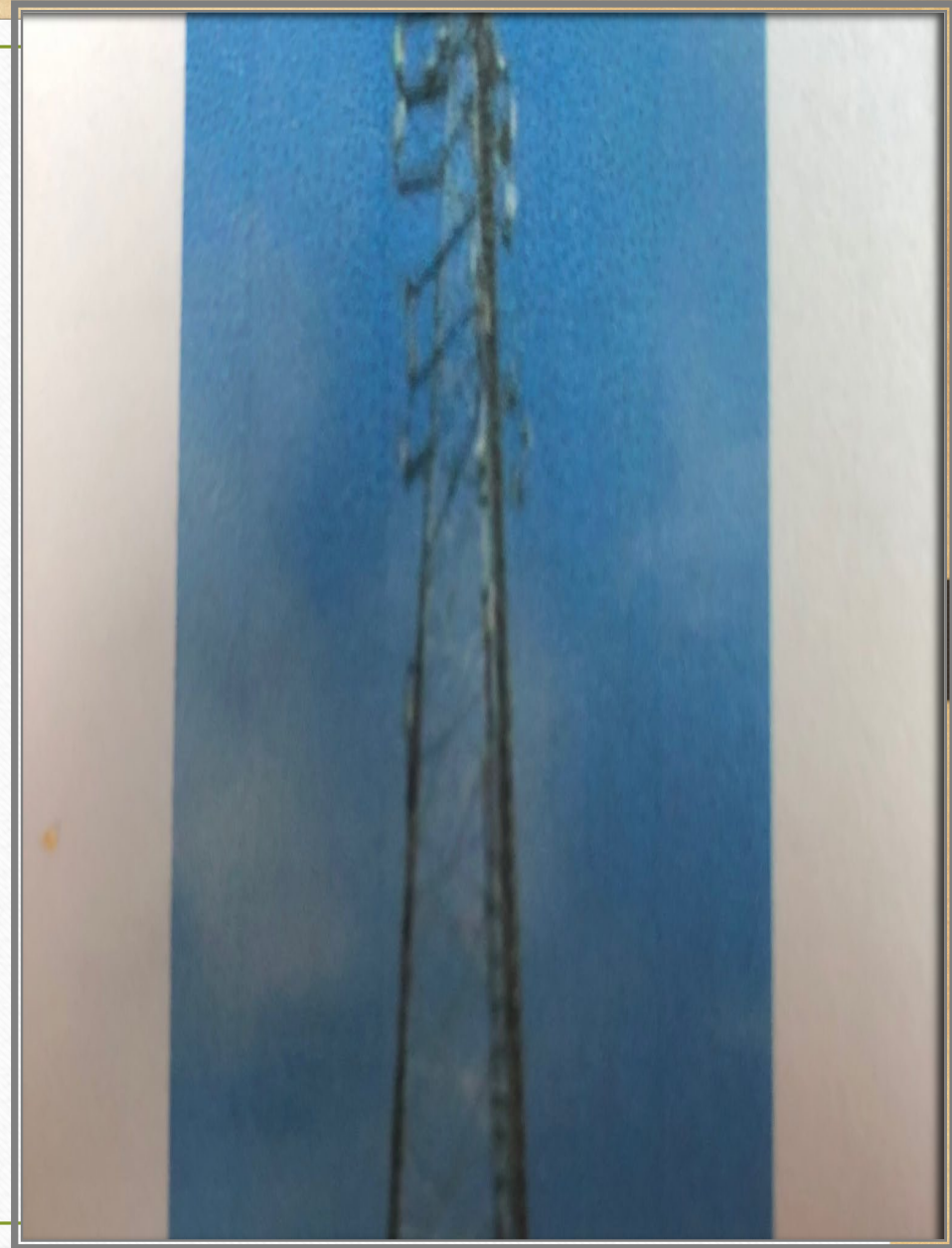
Visual Pollution has to end!

The picture is a cell tower.



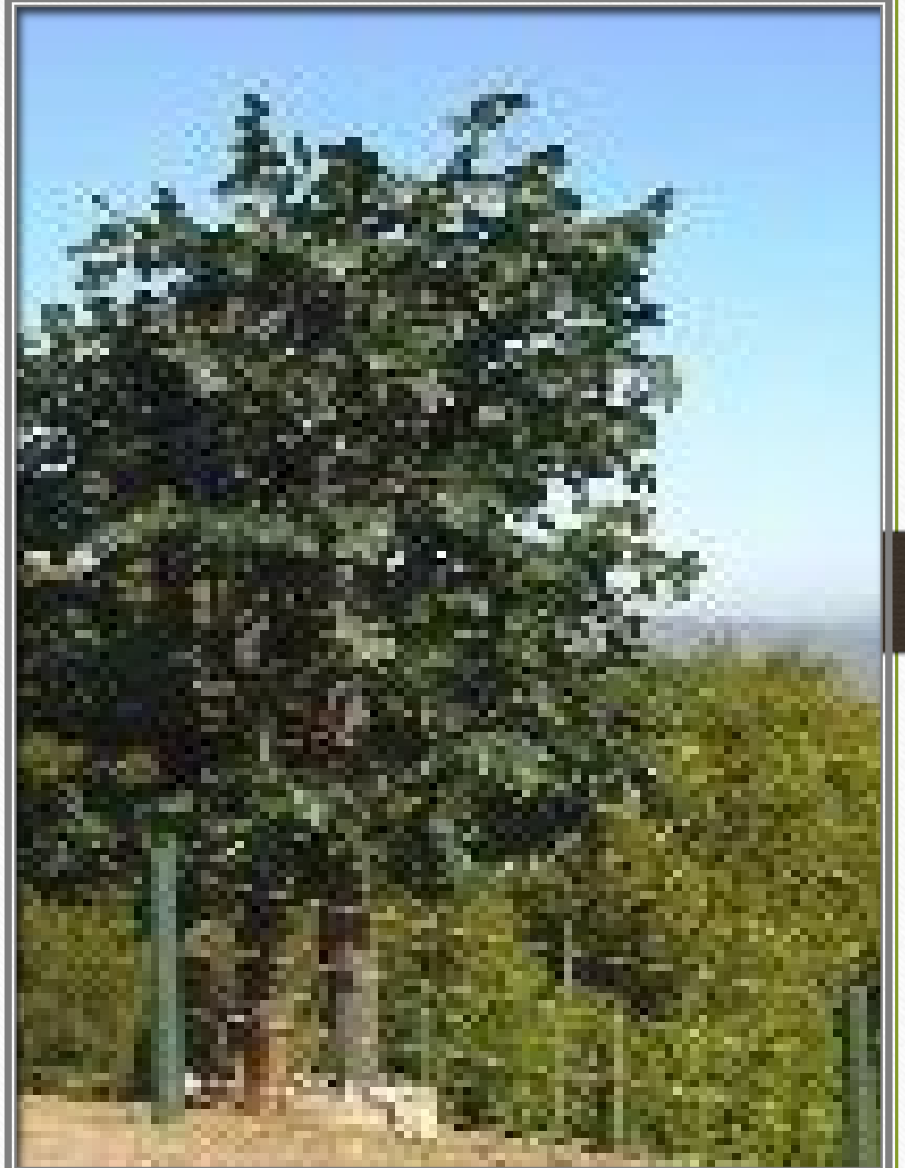
Something to blend to surroundings
