This notice of motion is read into the Council record on **March 12**, **2024**. The motion as read into the record will be debated on **March 26**, **2024**.

TITLE: Member Composition of the Subdivision and Development Appeal

Board

WHEREAS the County's Subdivision and Development Appeal Board is

established by Council in the *Appeal and Review Panel Bylaw C-7717-2017* in accordance with Part 17 of the *Municipal Government Act* to hear appeals on decisions made by the County's subdivision or

development authority;

AND WHEREAS the Subdivision and Development Appeal Board is an arms-length

quasi-judicial tribunal that must be impartial when hearing appeals,

owing a duty of fairness to all participants;

AND WHEREASCouncil is committed to ensuring the impartiality and independence of

the Subdivision and Development Appeal Board;

AND WHEREASCouncil is the governing body that passes municipal legislation that

regulates land use and the Subdivision and Development Appeal

Board interprets this municipal legislation in its decisions;

AND WHEREAS Council acts as subdivision or development authority for some

applications;

AND WHEREAS the current membership of the Subdivision and Development Appeal

Board includes one Councillor which may lead to real or perceived conflicts between the duties of a Councillor and the duties of the

Subdivision and Development Appeal Board;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT Administration prepare amendments to the *Appeal and Review Panel By-law C-7717-2017* that includes changes to the member composition of the Subdivision and Development Appeal Board so as to be comprised of nine Members at Large only;

AND THAT the amendments be presented to Council for consideration at the April 9, 2024 Regular Council Meeting;

AND THAT the member composition amendment take effect following approval of an amended *Appeal and Review Panel Bylaw C-7717-2017*, factoring in the Subdivision and Development Appeal Board's needs such as vacancies and active hearings and decisions.
