

# **BYLAW C-8175-2021**

A bylaw of Rocky View County, in the Province of Alberta, for the purpose of closing public travel and creating title to portions of a public highway in accordance with the *Municipal Government Act*.

WHEREAS the lands hereafter described are no longer required for public travel;

**AND WHEREAS** an application has been made to the Council of Rocky View County to have the highway closed;

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of Rocky View County deems it expedient to close for public travel certain roads, or portions of roads, situated in Rocky View County and to dispose of the same;

**AND WHEREAS** notice of this bylaw was provided in accordance with the *Municipal Government Act* by circulation to landowners and advertisements in the May 4, 2021, and the May 11, 2021, Rocky View County Public Hearing Notice;

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of Rocky View County was not petitioned for an opportunity to be heard by any person claiming to be prejudicially affected by this bylaw;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of Rocky View County enacts as follows:

#### **Title**

1 This bylaw may be cited as *Bylaw C-8175-2021*.

#### **Definitions**

- Words in this bylaw have the same meaning as those set out in the *Municipal Government Act* except for the definitions provided below:
  - (1) "Council" means the duly elected Council of Rocky View County:
  - (2) "Municipal Government Act" means the Municipal Government Act, RSA 2000, c M-26, as amended or replaced from time to time; and
  - (3) "Rocky View County" means Rocky View County as a municipal corporation and the geographical area within its jurisdictional boundaries, as the context requires.

### **Effect**

- The Council of Rocky View County does hereby close public travel for the purpose of creating title to the following described highway as shown on Schedule 'A' attached to and forming part of this bylaw, subject to the rights of access granted by other legislation:
  - (1) Road Plan 3321Q, containing ±0.42 hectares (±1.03 acres) more or less excepting thereout all mines and minerals;
