This report provides updates from ALUS Canada since the last update provided on May 19, 2021.

ALUS Canada is a national charitable organization that supports the delivery of the ALUS program across the country. Today, the program has evolved into a truly national and bilingual organization named "ALUS Canada" in both official languages. The Rocky View ALUS Coordinator works closely with ALUS Canada members to implement the program in the Rocky View region.


Aurora Cannabis


