Alberta Transportation	On review of the proposed road closure, it appears that at least three properties may be denied a physical and legal means of access to a road resulting from this closure. This may prevent Alberta Transportation's endorsement of the road closure bylaw.
	Alberta Transportation will review the information package after the public hearing. This information must include clarification regarding provision of a suitable and acceptable means of access to these parcels, and for ensuring public access to the bed and shore of the Elbow River.

Capital Projects- Engineering	Engineering recommends the refusal of the road closure application because without the road allowance as it exists, the properties to the South will not have legal access to a County Road, which would make further subdivision impossible. If the applicant would like to present an alternative road plan, then Engineering would be open to seeing it and providing comments then.
