

DECLARATION OF SUFFICIENT PETITION

For a local improvement tax to make upgrades to the Wintergreen Woods Water Utility raw water line, pumping and infrastructure required to satisfy Rocky View County and Alberta Environment requirements to provide potable water to residents, including any changes required for registration or provision of easements and land agreements currently defined as lining the raw water line and installing booster pump package and tie-ins, as well as supplying and installing water meters to each property.

Pursuant to sections 392(2) of the *Municipal Government Act (MGA)*, I, Dorian Wandzura, Chief Administrative Officer of Rocky View County, do hereby declare that the local improvement tax petition received on June 2, 2022 from David Deere meets the minimum requirements set out in the *MGA*, as noted below:

- 1. The petition is signed by two thirds of the owners who would be liable to pay for the local improvement tax; and
- 2. The owners who signed the petition represent at least half of the value of the assessments prepared under Part 9 for the parcels of land in respect to which the tax will be imposed.
