SUBJECT: Regional Off-Site Levy Bylaws Update

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The purpose of this report is to provide Council with an update on Off-Site Levy collections and the projects supported through the Off-Site Levy Fund reporting period between January 1, 2021 and July 31, 2022. The following Off-site Levy Bylaws were passed by Council on June 9, 2020, and are active:

- Bylaw C-8007-2020: Regional Transportation Off-Site Levy Bylaw
- Bylaw C-8008-2020: Regional Stormwater Off-Site Levy Bylaw
- Bylaw C-8009-2020: Regional Water and Wastewater Off-Site Levy Bylaw

Levies collected and levy funds contributed between January 1, 2021 and July 31, 2022 can be summarized as follows:

- Regional Transportation Off-Site Levies collected include \$8,538,878 in 2021 and \$3,740,182 in 2022 up to July 31. The Off-Site Levy Fund has provided \$16,540,700 towards transportation projects in 2021, 2022 and 2023.
- Regional Stormwater Off-Site Levies collected include \$859,539 in 2021 and \$69,807 in 2022 up to July 31. The Off-Site Levy Fund provided \$1,694,000 to the Co-operative Stormwater Management Initiative (CSMI) in 2021.
- Regional Water & Wastewater Off-Site Levies collected include \$4,569,751 in 2021 and \$2,905,587 in 2022 up to July 31. These funds have been used to pay down the initial capital and borrowing costs associated with the servicing infrastructure contained in the bylaws.

Off-site levies are important funding mechanisms to balance the benefits and costs of growth within Rocky View County. The levies ensure that new development pays a proportionate share of the costs needed for the improvement and long-term sustainability of the County's infrastructure network resulting from that growth.

BACKGROUND:

Regional Transportation Off-Site Levy

A summary of the Regional Transportation Off-Site Levy collections since January 1, 2021 is as follows:

These levies have been collected under two (2) bylaws:1) Bylaw C-7356-2014; and 2) Bylaw C-8007-2020.

Bylaw C-7356-2014 remains in effect until payment of any amounts imposed on Subdivision and Development applications within Bylaw C-7356-2014 have been paid or satisfied, after which the bylaw is automatically repealed.

As of December 31, 2021, the balance of the Transportation Off-Site Levy Reserve Fund is \$30,720,466. Collected levies are transferred to the reserve fund at the end of each year. In January 2022, \$1,473,980.31 was transferred from the reserve as part of cost recovery payments to Ivanhoe Cambridge for transportation and general municipal infrastructure in the East Balzac area.

The Transportation Off-Site Levy Fund has been utilized to support the following projects:

A summary of the Regional Stormwater Off-Site Levy collections since January 1, 2021 is as follows:

These levies have been collected under two (2) bylaws: 1) Bylaw C-7535-2015; and 2) Bylaw C-8008-2020.

Bylaw C-7535-2015 remains in effect until payment of any amounts imposed on Subdivision and Development applications within Bylaw C-7535-2015 have been paid or satisfied, after which the bylaw is automatically repealed.

As of December 31, 2021, the balance of the Stormwater Off-Site Levy Reserve Fund is \$1,855,005. Collected levies are transferred to the reserve fund at the end of each year.

The Stormwater Off-Site Levy Fund was used to fund the initial stages of the Co-operative Stormwater Management Initiative (CSMI) in 2021 totaling \$1,694,000.

Regional Water and Wastewater Off-Site Levy

A summary of the Regional Wastewater Off-Site Levy collections since January 1, 2021 is as follows:

These levies have been collected under two (2) bylaws: 1) Bylaw C-7273-2013; and 2) Bylaw C-8009-2020.

Bylaw C-7273-2013 remains in effect until payment of any amounts imposed on Subdivision and Development applications within Bylaw C-7273-2013 have been paid or satisfied, after which the bylaw is automatically repealed.

As of December 31, 2021, the balance of the Wastewater Off-Site Levy Reserve Fund is \$507,166 and the balance of the Water Off-Site Levy Reserve Fund is \$202,335. Collected levies are transferred to the reserve fund at the end of each year.

All payments related to the water and wastewater off-site levy bylaw have been applied to servicing the County's borrowing costs for the infrastructure included within the bylaw.
