

## **Notice of Motion – Creation of an Aggregate Resource Plan**

**WHEREAS** the County Plan speaks to preparing an aggregate extraction policy and developing an aggregate management plan in consultation with residents, industry, and stakeholder groups.

**And WHEREAS** The County has thousands of years of gravel reserves;

**And WHEREAS** providing rules around where gravel may or may not be extracted provides assurances to residents, industry, and stakeholders;

**And WHEREAS** we have heard through industry presentations to Council that many existing local gravel pits are nearing end of their life expectancy and industry is actively seeking alternate locations to extract gravel;

**And WHEREAS** creating a gravel policy ranked in the top 10 of this Council's list of strategic initiatives;

**And WHEREAS** much work has already been undertaken on the previous Aggregate Resource Plan that may be salvaged and worked into a new document.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** That Administration be directed to create a Terms of Reference for an Aggregate Resource Plan, and includes a cost estimate based on a completion date of no later than October 31st, 2024;

**And THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that Administration return to Council with a report no later than March 31st, 2023.
